Vice Provost for Enrollment Management

I am pleased to announce that Rosalind V. Alderman, Ph.D. has accepted the position of Vice Provost for Enrollment Management.

In May, Rosalind agreed to serve in an interim role to lead the University's recruitment and retention efforts until the search process was completed to fill this critical leadership position. And once again, after a national search, led by a strong committee of faculty, staff and administrators, one of our own has been identified as the top candidate. Feedback from the campus interviews confirms she is the right fit, and she has the support and confidence of our community to lead these key operations.

Immediately, Rosalind will help lead the search for an experienced leader to replace Nelson Delgado, Dean of the Office of Admission, who recently accepted a position at another institution. Rosalind will be looking for someone who is entrepreneurial and innovative in recruitment to join her in seeking new and refined ways for reaching the twenty-first-century student.

Before stepping into the Interim Vice Provost position, Rosalind served as the Assistant Vice President for Retention Management. She began her career at St. Mary's in 1993 and has served in several positions, including Assistant Director for Residence Life, Associate Dean of Students, and Project Director for the University's Title V Grant. Rosalind received her Master of Arts in College Student Personnel from Bowling Green State University and her Ph.D. in Educational Administration from Texas A&M University, College Station.
